I'd like to wish everyone a happy and enjoyable half term, and look forward to seeing everyone back on Monday 4th November!





In history, we have been looking at a range of census and many historical events through them.







Do you live in Warboys? Need help with your education? Could a grant help you? Or do you belong to a village youth group that needs better equipment to further the education and development of young people?


Young people must live within the parish of Warboys or within half a mile of the parish boundary and must be aged less than 25 years. It can be used for:

- * Special educational materials like books or equipment for college or university
- * Special tools or equipment needed for undergoing specific training or starting out in a craft or trade
- * Special sporting equipment or musical instruments
- * Education travel to broaden the education and experience of young people
- To allow young people to undergo special training courses that may not otherwise be available to them.






Lunch menus - Week One






